How does a pizza box grow?

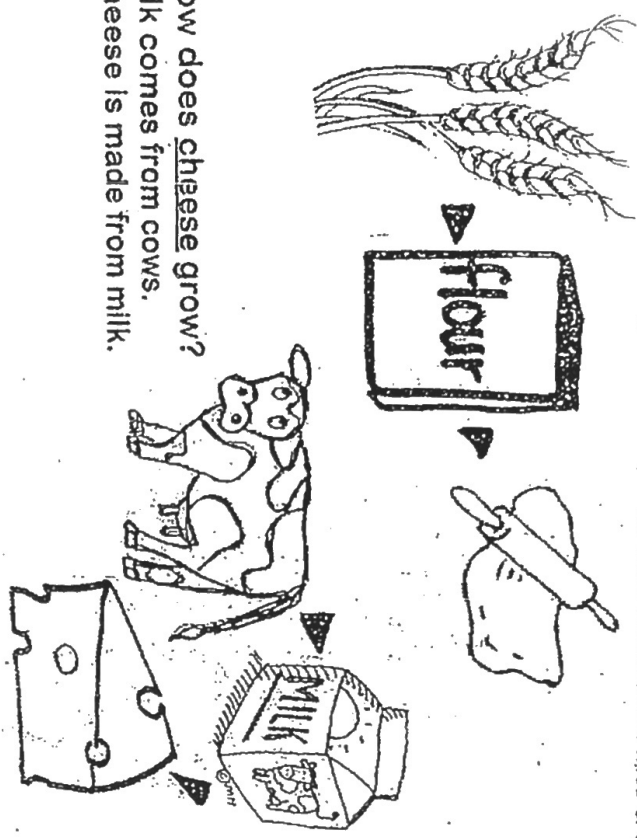

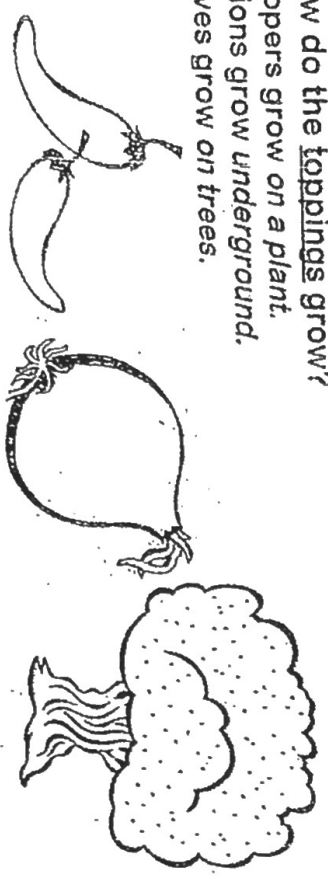

Flour is used to form dough that is rolled and stretched into a circle.

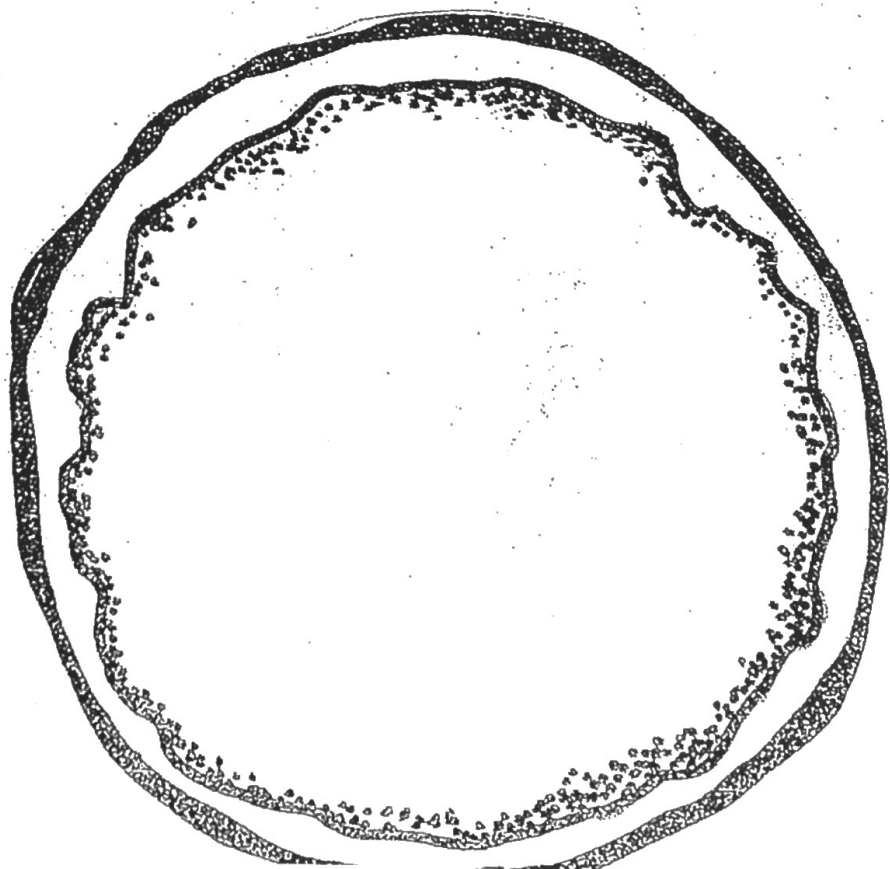


How does cheese grow?

Cheese is made from milk.

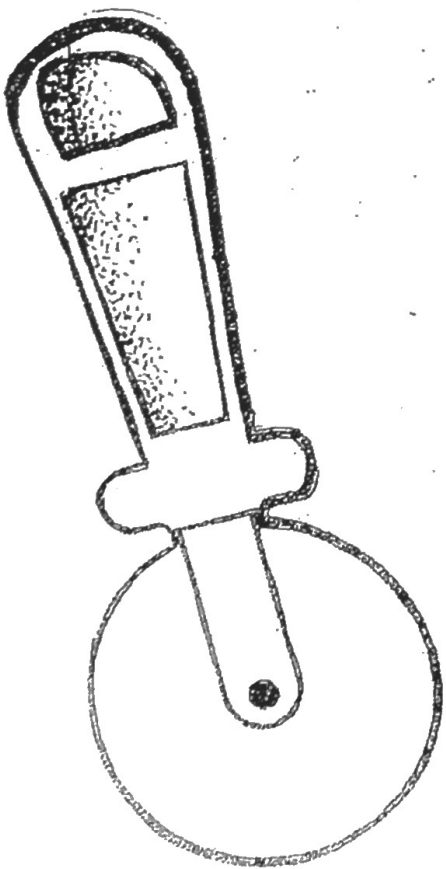
How do the toppings grow?
