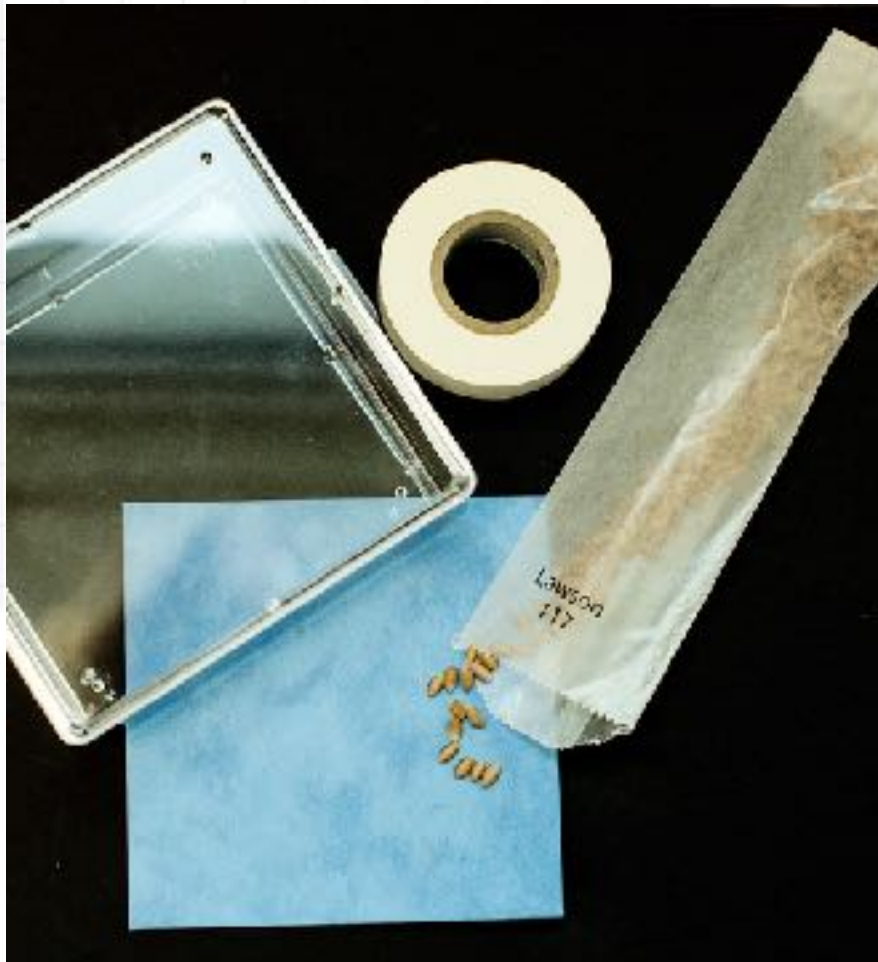


Growing wheat seed in germination boxes



- Materials
 - germination boxes
 - blotter paper
 - labeling tape
 - seed
 - water bottle



- The bread wheat, durum wheat, barley, and rye seed are ready for planting from the packet



- The einkorn wheat is still covered with the flower parts [glumes]



- Carefully peel away the outer parts of the flower to uncover the seed inside.



- This is what the ‘cleaned’ seed should look like. Most of the time, there is only one seed per floret, hence the name ‘ein [one] korn [seed]’



- Place the germination paper in the box and moisten with water.
- Place seed in box with embryo up
